Our eighth project, the expansion at Case New Holland Industrial, came online Oct 27th. The installation expands our production capacity which continues to build a strong financial foundation for our co-operative. The combined installations at CNHI have a 792 kW direct current generation capacity reducing the CNHI greenhouse gas emissions by approximately 650 tonnes a year, which is the equivalent of 140 residential homes.

Shares to support financing this latest project are currently available. Shares can be purchased by current members or new members, as individuals or groups. Our shares are available for a limited time only. The share offering closes on March 31, 2024.



"We joined the Solar Co-op when we were living in an apartment downtown and wanted to find ways to offset some of our energy consumption. The Co-op offered the opportunity to invest in an expansion of solar, and in a way that was community-led and supportive of other good work happening in Saskatoon. Justin was spending time working out of the Two Twenty co-working space, home of the Co-op's first installation. We had also just joined the local Car Share Co-op, which was collaborating with the Solar Co-op on the Renewable Rides program, building infrastructure to charge electric vehicles with solar power.
